Psa. 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Thy word is settled in heaven. Psa. 119:90 Thy faithfulness continues throughout all generations; Thou didst establish the earth, and it stands.

Heb. 13:6 so that we confidently say, "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid. What shall man do to me?"

Psa. 37:28 For the LORD loves justice, And does not forsake His godly ones; They are preserved forever; But the descendants of the wicked will be cut off.
