

John 20:30, “And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book;

Dan. 7:14, “Then to Him [Son of Man] was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed.”

Rev. 3:21, “To him who overcomes I [Jesus] will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.”

Dan. 7:21, “I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them,

Dan. 7:22, “until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.”

Premillennialism

Already, but not yet



Inaugurated, and progressively coming in

Eph. 1:22, “And He [God the Father] put all things under His [God the Son] feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,”

Eph. 4:15, “but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—”

Eph. 5:23, “For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.”

Col. 1:18, “And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.”

Col. 2:10, “and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.”

Col. 2:19, “and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God.”
