**Dan. 7:14, “Then to Him [Son of Man] was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed.”**

**Rev. 3:21, “To him who overcomes I [Jesus] will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.”**

**Dan. 7:21, “I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them,**

**Dan. 7:22, “until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.”**

Jesus returns *before* the beginning of the kingdom



# Premillennialism

Already, but not yet



Inaugurated, and progressively coming in

**Eph. 1:22, “And He [God the Father] put all things under His [God the Son] feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,”**

**Eph. 4:15, “but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—”**

**Eph. 5:23, “For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.”**

**Col. 1:18, “And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.”**

**Col. 2:10, “and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.”**

**Col. 2:19, “and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God.”**

**John 17:17, “Sanctify them by Your truth.  
Your word is truth.**

**John 17:18, “As You sent Me into the world, I
