

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<u>1 Cor. 10:31</u>, "Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." <u>Gen. 49:8</u>, "Judah, you are he whom your brothers shall praise; Your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; Your father's children shall bow down before you.



<u>2 Sam. 5:1</u>, "Then all the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron and spoke, saying, 'Indeed we are your bone and your flesh.

<u>2 Sam. 5:2</u>, "'Also, in time past, when Saul was king over us, you were the one who led Israel out and brought them in; and the LORD said to you, "You shall shepherd My people Israel, and be ruler over Israel." " 2 Sam. 5:3, "Therefore all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David made a covenant with them at Hebron before the LORD. And they anointed David king over Israel.

2 Sam. 5:4, "David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years.

2 Sam. 5:5, "In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months, and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty-three years over all Israel and Judah."



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<u>Gen. 2:23,</u> "And Adam said: 'This is now <u>bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh;</u> She shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.'"

<u>Gen. 29:14</u>, "And Laban said to him, 'Surely you are my bone and my flesh.' And he stayed with him for a month."

Judg. 9:2, "Please speak in the hearing of all the men of Shechem: 'Which is better for you, that all seventy of the sons of Jerubbaal reign over you, or that one reign over you?' Remember that I am your own <u>flesh and bone</u>."

<u>2 Sam. 19:12, "You are my brethren,</u> you are <u>my bone and my flesh</u>. Why then are you the last to bring back the king?"

Eph. 5:30, "For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones."
