Sending authorized and trained people

**To cross language and/or cultural
divisions**

To communicate the gospel and the teach of the Word of God and the whole realm of Bible doctrine, beyond the cultural border of the local, home church.

Missions technically refers to a form of cross cultural evangelism where designated individuals are set apart by a local church to carry out the work of communicating the gospel, teaching the Word of God and the whole realm of bible doctrine, with the end result of creating a self-supporting indigenous ministry. Part of any such endeavor involves the training and preparation of those involved to accurately handle and teach the Word of God, thus, the support of such training institutions is also a part of missions.

Ex 19:3 And Moses went up to God, and the Lord called to him from the mountain, saying, “Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel:

Ex 19:4 ‘You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and *how* I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to Myself.

Ex 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine.

Ex 19:6 And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’ These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.”

**Nu 14:24 But My servant Caleb,
because he has a different spirit in him
