

Seven Realities of the Abrahamic Covenant

- 1. I will make you a great nation.
- 2. I will bless you.
- 3. I will make your name great.
- 4. And you will be a blessing (the imperative expresses the results of the command).
- 5. I will also bless those who bless you.
- 6. and him who curses you I will curse.
- 7. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed.

Joshua 24:3, "Then I took your father Abraham from the other side of the River, led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his descendants and gave him Isaac." <u>Genesis 41:46</u>, "Joseph was thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt." <u>Genesis 12:10</u>, "Now there was a famine in the land, and Abram went down to Egypt to dwell there, for the famine was severe in the land." Adversity: The inevitable, outside, daily pressures of life that attack and seek to penetrate the soul.

Stress: The optional, inside pressure of the soul caused by reaction to the external pressures of adversity. When the believer negative to Bible doctrine allows adversity to penetrate his thinking he has succumbed to the arrogance skills.
