

## Objective Genitive: Revelation about Christ

Subjective Genitive: Christ's revelation or the revelation Christ gave

Galatians 2:16, "nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus [literally, faith of Christ Jesus], even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in **Christ** [literally, faith of Christ Jesus] and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified."

**Daniel 2:45**, "Inasmuch as you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future; so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy."

<u>Matthew 24:2</u>, "And He said to them, 'Do you not see all these things? Truly I say to you, not one stone here will be left upon another, which will not be torn down.'

<u>Matthew 24:3</u>, "As He was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, 'Tell us, when will these things happen, and what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?' " <u>Matthew 24:4</u>, "And Jesus answered and said to them, 'See to it that no one misleads you. <u>Matthew 24:5</u>, "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will mislead many."

Matthew 24:6, "You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for those things must take place, but that is not yet the end [τὸ τέλος, to telos]. Matthew 24:7, "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there

will be famines and earthquakes."

Revelation 4:1, "After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a trumpet speaking with me, said, 'Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things.'"

<u>Revelation 22:6</u>, "And he said to me, 'These words are faithful and true'; and the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show to His bond-servants <u>the things which must</u> <u>soon take place</u>." <u>Revelation 11:15</u>, "Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, 'The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.' "

Revelation 20:4, "Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years."
