- 2. Character: a citation specific attributes of Christ
- 3. Commendation: a praise for spiritual advance
- 4. Condemnation: a warning about a spiritual flaw in the congregation
- 5. Correction: a prescription to recovery
- 6. Call: a command to listen and apply
- 7. Challenge: a personal promise of reward

works

labor patience: hupomones

not able to endure evil people

Evaluate: apostolic claims

Have patience: i.e., bastazo

Hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans

Endure adversity (tribulation/poverty)

Imprisoned for the faith

Living in adverse circumstances

Hold fast to Christ's name

Don't deny faith even in persecution

Service

Faith

Obedient application of doctrine

Condemnations

Left their first love

Compromised doctrinally with the doctrine of Balaam, Nicolaitans, Jezebel (this involves antinomianism, anti-Semitism, sexual licentiousness, idolatry)

Good reputation, but carnal, operating on human good and religion

Defiled (soiled, moluno)

Lukewarm, i.e,. spiritually useless

Self-deceived and self satisfied

(wretched, miserable, poor, blind, naked)

Corrections

Remember your first love

Be faithful until death

Repent of doctrinal compromise and antinomianism

Repent of sexual licentiousness

Be watchful

Strengthen your spiritual life

Remember what Christ did for you and grace

Hold fast

Buy gold refined, buy white garments, anoint your eyes

Be zealous

Challenge

Eat from the tree of life in the Paradise of God

Crown of life: not hurt by second death

Hidden Manna to eat

White stone with a new name

Morning Star

Name honored before God the Father and the Holy Spirit

Pillar in the temple
