

κρατέω kratéō; Pres Act PTCP 2s; Durative present: "you consistently adhere to …"

διδάσκω *didáskō*; aor act ind 3s, "to communicate, instruct"

2s; Durative consistently <u>Jude 1:11</u>, "Woe to them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, have run greedily in the error of Balaam for profit, and perished in the rebellion of Korah." <u>2 Peter 2:15</u>, "They have forsaken the right way and gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

2 Peter 2:16, "but he was rebuked for his iniquity: a dumb donkey speaking with a man's voice restrained the madness of the prophet."



Numbers 31:16, "Look, these women caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to trespass against the LORD in the incident of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD."
