



- and the dead in Christ will rise first."



Daniel's Seventieth Week

Dan. 9:16, "O Lord, in accordance with all Thy righteous acts, let now Thine anger and Thy wrath turn away from Thy city Jerusalem, Thy holy mountain; for because of our sins and the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and Thy people have become a reproach to all those around us."



Dan. 9:24, "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy place.

Dan. 9:25, "So you are to know and discern that from the <u>issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild</u> Jerusalem until <u>Messiah the Prince</u> there will be <u>seven weeks and sixty-two weeks</u>; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

Dan. 9:26, "Then <u>after the sixty-two weeks</u> the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

Dan. 9:27, "And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate."

Rationale for 360-Day Years

Half week-Daniel 9:27

Time, times, half a time— Daniel 7:25, 12:7; Rev. 12:14

1,260 days-Revelation 12:6, 11:3

42 months—Revelation 11:2, 13:5

Thus: 42 months = 1,260 days = time, times, half time + half week

Therefore: month = 30 days; year = 360 days

Explanation of Daniel's 70 Weeks of Years

- $69 \times 7 \times 360 = 173,880$ days
- March 5, 444 B.C. + 173,880 = March 30, A.D. 33

Verification

- 444 B.C. to A.D. 33 –1 (no year 0) = 476 years
- 476 years × 365.2421989 days = 173,855 days
- + days between March 5 and March 30 = 25 days

Totals = 173,880 days





Literal Interpretation

1. Definition

Imminency: the "at any moment" return of Jesus Christ.

OED: "hanging overhead, constantly ready to befall or overtake one; close at hand in its incidence."

It is certain it will occur, it is uncertain when it will occur;

It is NOT contingent on any other events;

and NO prophesied event intervenes between the present time and the Rapture.

"EAGERLY WAIT"

Heb. 9:28, "so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation."

"EAGERLY WAIT"

Pictures eager expectation indicated by the head bent forward to catch the first glance of an advancing procession.
