


There will be two stages or phases of the *abomination of desolation*:

Phase 1 – The presence of the Antichrist himself in the temple – in the Holy of Holies (2 Thess. 2:4)

Phase 2 – The image of the Antichrist in the temple (Rev. 13:11-15). This image will remain in the temple for another 30 days after the Antichrist is cast into the Lake of Fire (Dan. 12:11).

Matt. 24:15, "Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand),

"And there was given me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, 'rise and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and those who worship in it'." (11:1)

"And leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for fortytwo months." (11:2)

"And I will grant authority to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for twelve hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth." "These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth. And if anyone desires to harm them, fire proceeds out of their mouth and devours their enemies; and if anyone would desire to harm them, in **FLUAH** this manner he must be killed." (11:3–5)

"And a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars; and she was with child; and she cried out, being in labor and in pain to give birth." (12:1-2)



ANGELIC ANNOUNCEMENTS

First Announcement

Preaches the gospel worldwide and warns of impending judgment.

"I saw another angel flying in midheaven, having an eternal gospel to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people; and he said with a loud voice, 'Fear God, and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters." (14:6–7)

ANGELIC ANNOUNCEMENTS

Second Announcement

The Kingdom of Man, Babylon the Great, is Fallen.

"And another angel, a second one, followed, saying, 'Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who has made all the nations drink of the wine of the passion of her immorality." (14:8)

ANGELIC ANNOUNCEMENTS Third Announcement

All receiving the mark of the beast are destined for the Lake of Fire for eternity.

"And another angel, a third one, followed them, saying with a loud voice, 'If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives a mark on his forehead or upon his hand, he also will drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb...." (14:9–13)
