
#### DANIEL 8



#### **S**YMBOLS

Ram = Medo-Persian Empire

2 horns = Medes + Persians (Dan. 8:20)


Higher horn = Persians are stronger, developed later.

West, North, South = the directions the MP Empire expanded

Lopsided Bear = One side is the Medes, the other the Persians are higher.

Three Ribs = Three major conquests of the Persians Median, Lydian, Babylonian Empires





# Middle East Persian Empire 500 BC










