

Rev. 16:12, “Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared.

Rev. 16:13, “And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.”





Rev. 16:14, “(For they are spirits of demons performing signs), which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.”



The Day of the Lord

- The “day of the Lord” is a general term used for a time of divine judgment. It is also used as a specific term for the end of the Tribulation judgment and again for the final destruction of the present heavens and earth.
- The day here refers to the campaign of Armageddon, the war between the nations of the earth and God (Psa 2:1–3; Dan. 11:43, 44; Joel 2:10–3:2; Zech 14:2, 3; Rev 19:11–21).
- The “day” in the Tribulation is accompanied by astro-geophysical disturbances: earthquakes, thunder, lightnings, sun darkened, moon turned to blood (Joel 2:10ff; Matt. 24:29–31; Rev 16:16)

Zech. 14:2, "For I will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem; the city shall be taken, the houses rifled, and the women ravished. Half of the city shall go into captivity, but the remnant of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

Zech. 14:3, "Then the LORD will go forth and fight against those nations, as He fights in the day of battle."

Rev. 16:15, "Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame."


1 Th. 5:2, “For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.”

1 Th. 5:4, “But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief.”

John 10:10, “The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”


