Rev. 19:8, "And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints." 1 Th. 4:17, "Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord." 1. It is crucial to mark the distinction between the Wedding and the Marriage Supper or Feast.

2. It is also crucial to mark the distinction between the marriage of Yhwh to Israel and the marriage of the church to Christ.

3. In the Old Testament Israel is described as the wife of Yhwh.

Jer. 3:14, " 'Return, O backsliding children,' says the LORD; 'for I am married to you. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion.' "

Is. 54:5, "For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is His name; and your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth."

Ezek. 16:8, " 'When I passed by you again and looked upon you, indeed your time was the time of love; so I spread My wing over you and covered your nakedness. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine,' says the Lord GOD." Is. 50:1, "Thus says the LORD: 'Where is the certificate of your mother's divorce, whom I have put away? Or which of My creditors is it to whom I have sold you? For your iniquities you have sold yourselves, and for your transgressions your mother has been put away.'"

Eph. 5:24, "Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

Eph. 5:25, "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her," Eph. 5:26, "that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,

Eph. 5:27, "that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish."
