

**Plurality in the Godhead:
Trinity and *Perichoresis***

Rev 21:5–6



Rev. 1:4, “John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne,”

Rev. 3:21, “To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.”

Rev. 5:13, “And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: ‘Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!’ ”

**Rev. 6:16, “and said to the mountains and rocks,
‘Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who
sits on the throne and from the wrath of the
Lamb!’ ”**

Rev. 7:9, “After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,

Rev. 7:10, “and crying out with a loud voice, saying, ‘Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!’ ”

Rev. 7:15, “Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.

Rev. 7:17, “for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”

Rev. 12:5, “She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.”

Rev. 19:4, “And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, ‘Amen! Alleluia!’ ”

Rev. 22:1, “And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb.”

Rev. 22:3, “And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.”

Rev. 1:6, “and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.”

Rev. 1:8, “ ‘I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,’ says the Lord God, ‘who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.’ ”

Rev. 22:13, “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.”

Rev. 1:4, “John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne,”

Rev. 4:8, “The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: ‘Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!’ ”

Rev. 11:17, “saying: ‘We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was and who is to come, because You have taken Your great power and reigned.’ ”

Rev. 15:3, “They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: ‘Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints!’ ”

Rev. 16:7, “And I heard another from the altar saying, ‘Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments.’ ”

Rev. 16:14, “For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.”


Rev. 19:6, “And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, ‘Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!’ ”

Rev. 19:15, “Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.”

Rev. 21:22, “But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.”

1. Definition:

Trinity: God exists in three equal Persons who have identical essence, and are co-equal and co-eternal.



John 14:10, “Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

John 14:11, “Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves.”

**Deut 6:4, “Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our
God, the Lord alone.” (Tanakh)**

“Then King David said to the entire assembly, ‘My son Solomon, whom ALONE God has chosen, is still young and inexperienced and the work is great; for the temple is not for man, but for the LORD God.’ ”

1 Chronicles 29:1 (Tanakh)

“King David said to the entire assemblage, ‘God has chosen my son Solomon alone, an untried lad, although the work to be done is vast—for the temple is not for a man but for the Lord God.’ ”

Isa. 48:16, “Come near to Me, listen to this: From the first I have not spoken in secret, from the time it took place, I was there. And now the Lord GOD has sent Me, and His Spirit.”

Hos. 1:7, “But I will have compassion on the house of Judah and deliver them by the LORD their God, and will not deliver them by bow, sword, battle, horses, or horsemen.”

Isa. 59:21, “ ‘And as for Me, this is My covenant with them,’ says the LORD: ‘My Spirit which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring’s offspring,’ says the LORD, ‘from now and forever.’ ”

Isa. 63:9, “In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them; in His love and in His mercy He redeemed them; and He lifted them and carried them all the days of old.

Isa. 63:10, “But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit; Therefore, He turned Himself to become their enemy, He fought against them.”

Matt. 28:18, “And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, ‘All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

**Matt. 28:19, “ ‘Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name’ ”
[Name=Essence, because they have the same essence they have the same authority]. If three gods He would have said NAMES of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.**

Matt. 28:20, “ ‘teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.’ ”

**2 Cor. 13:14, “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ,
and the love of God, and the fellowship of the
Holy Spirit, be with you all.”**
