

[Salvation is a free gift]

Rev. 21:7, “He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. [overcoming is a work resulting in inheritance blessing]

Rev. 21:8, “But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part [meros inheritance portion] in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”

Rev. 22:15, “But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.”

1 Corinthians 3:15, “If anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.”

Rev. 22:16, “I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star.”

Isa. 11:1, “There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots.”
