


Ecclesiastical Trends in the Church Age

- 5. Correction: a prescription to recovery
- 6. Call: a command to listen and apply
- 7. Challenge: a personal promise of reward













The 70th Week of Israel








There will be two stages or phases of the abomination of desolation:

Phase 1 – The presence of the Antichrist himself in the temple – in the Holy of holies (2 Thess. 2:4)

Phase 2 – The image of the Antichrist in the temple (Rev. 13:11–15). This image will remain in the temple for another 30 days after the Antichrist is cast into the Lake of Fire (Dan. 12:11).
