SUMMARY POINTS

- 1. Authority is not part of the created order but part of the makeup of the Triune Godhead.
- 2. At the very center of all authority is God who is the Source of all authority.
- 3. Authority is necessary for any social group, organization, or order to function.
- 4. Authority was the ultimate issue in the angelic conflict, so authority becomes the ultimate issue in the believer's spiritual life. Not only the authority of God, but also response to other authorities which God has established.
