- **Total Contradiction between Christianity and Unbelief**
 - Colossians 2:1-9
 - Genesis 1-3 and Hebrews 1:1-3
 - Romans 1:18-23
 - Psalm 19:1-6
- **Relevance to Sufficiency**
 - Scripture is the only game in town.

Colossians 2:1-10

For I want you to know what a great conflict I have for you and those in Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh, that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding,

Two Possible Interpretations

- God's revelation in Scripture is the sole sufficient foundation upon which to build the Christian's life of ministry

Reclaiming Lost Ground: Yoga

- 1. No Christian should participate in Hinduism.
