

Layout of the Tabernacle








Golden Candlestick

תְּבְׁלְּבְּ (pārōket), curtain in front of the Most Holy Place. 15x "that which shuts off" רַבְּבֶּלְת ($t^e k \bar{e} let$) blue, violet; bluish purple. Symbolic of heaven as the true dwelling of God and the heavenly origin of the Tabernacle.

HEAVEN

אַרְגְּיִן ʾ*argāmān* purple, reddish purple. Signifies royalty.

ROYALTY
