## “The Bible and Capitalism, Socialism and Communism” Acts 4:32–5:16



**Matt. 6:19, “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal;**

**Matt. 6:20, “but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.**

**Matt. 6:21, “For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”**

**1 Tim. 6:10, “For the love of money [φιλαργυρία *philarguria*] is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.”**

**2 Tim. 3:2, “For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,”**

**Luke 12:15, “And He said to them, ‘Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.’ ”**

**Col. 3:5, “Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.”**

**Acts 4:32, “Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common.”**

**2 Thess. 3:10, “For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.”**

**Prov. 31:10, “Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies.**

**Prov. 31:11, “The heart of her husband safely trusts her; so he will have no lack of gain.**

**Prov. 31:12, “She does him good and not evil all the days of her life.**

**Prov. 31:13, “She seeks wool and flax, and willingly works with her hands.”**

**Prov. 31:15, “She also rises while it is yet night, and provides food for her household, and a portion for her maidservants.**

**Prov. 31:17, “She girds herself with strength, and strengthens her arms.”**

**Prov. 31:18, “She perceives that her merchandise is good, and her lamp does not go out by night.**

**Prov. 31:19, “She stretches out her hands to the distaff, and her hand holds the spindle.**

**Prov. 31:20, “She extends her hand to the poor, Yes, she reaches out her hands to the needy.”**

**Acts 4:29, “Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word,**

**Acts 4:30, “by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”**
