

## Summary of Acts 1–12 The Holy Spirit and Church Growth


and even to the remotest part of the earth."

### What the Holy Spirit Brought New

- 1. A new organism: the CHURCH
- 2. The Baptism by the Holy Spirit: Uniting us with Christ, "in Christ," a new people, a new family, a new identity, new spiritual resources, new spiritual destiny, new Holy Spirit ministries (baptism, indwelling, filling, gifts, sealing).
- 3. A new objective: to be a witness throughout the world.

B. The Lord gives birth to and the Holy Spirit expands the Church in Jerusalem. (2:1–7:60)

  - A. God allows persecution to drive the Church out of Jerusalem. (8:1–8)
  - B. God sends Philip out to the Samaritans and demonstrates their unity with the work in Jerusalem by a similar outpouring of the Holy Spirit by the hands of Peter and John. (8:4–40)
  - C. God saves Saul which prepares the way for the Gentiles. (9:1–31)

- II. God expands the witness of the Church into Judea and Samaria. (8:1–12:25)
  - C. God saves Saul which prepares the way for the Gentiles. (9:1–31)
  - D. God directs Peter to take the Gospel to Cornelius and the Gentiles. (10:1–11:18)
