Isa. 55:3, “Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you—The sure mercies of David.”

Jer. 23:5, “ ‘Behold, the days are coming,’ says the LORD, ‘That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

Jer. 23:6, “ ‘In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.’ ”

Jer. 33:14, “ ‘Behold, the days are coming,’ says the LORD, ‘that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah:

Jer. 33:20, “Thus says the LORD: ‘If you can break My covenant with the day and My covenant with the night, so that there will not be day and night in their season,

Jer. 33:21, “ ‘then My covenant may also be broken with David My servant, so that he shall not have a son to reign on his throne, and with the Levites, the priests, My ministers.

Jer. 33:22, “ ‘As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, nor the sand of the sea measured, so will I multiply the descendants of David My servant and the Levites who minister to Me.’ ”

Ezek. 37:24, “David My servant shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd; they shall also walk in My judgments and observe My statutes, and do them.

Ezek. 37:25, “Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, their children, and their children’s children, forever; and My servant David shall be their prince forever.

Ezek. 37:26, “Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.”

Ezek. 21:27, “ ‘Overthrown, overthrown, I will make it overthrown! It shall be no longer, Until He comes whose right it is, And I will give it to Him.’ ”

Ezek. 34:23, “I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them—My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd.”

Hos. 3:4, “For the children of Israel shall abide many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred pillar, without ephod or teraphim.

Hos. 3:5, “Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the LORD their God and David their king. They shall fear the LORD and His goodness in the latter days.”

Jer. 30:8, “ ‘For it shall come to pass in that day,’ says the LORD of hosts, ‘That I will break his yoke from your neck, and will burst your bonds; Foreigners shall no more enslave them.

Jer. 30:9, “ ‘But they shall serve the LORD their God, and David their king, Whom I will raise up for them.’ ”

Psa. 132:12, “If your sons will keep My covenant and My testimony which I shall teach them, Their sons also shall sit upon your throne forevermore.”

Psa. 132:17, “ ‘There I will make the horn of David grow; I will prepare a lamp for My Anointed.’ ”

**Psa. 89:29, “His seed also I will make to endure forever,
And his throne as the days of heaven.”**

**Psa. 89:36, “His seed shall endure forever, And his throne
as the sun before Me;**

**Psa. 89:37, “It shall be established forever like the moon,
Even like the faithful witness in the sky.” Selah.**

**Acts 13:35, “Therefore He also says in another Psalm:
‘You will not allow Your Holy One to see corruption.’ ”**

Psa. 16:10, “For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.”

Acts 2:27, “For You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.”

Acts 13:36, “For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell asleep, was buried with his fathers, and saw corruption;”
