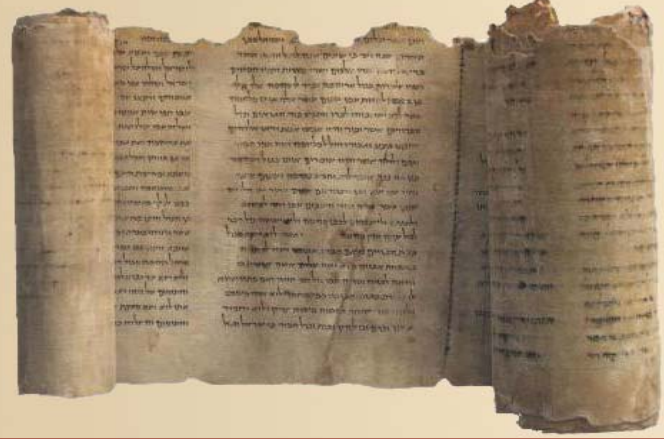

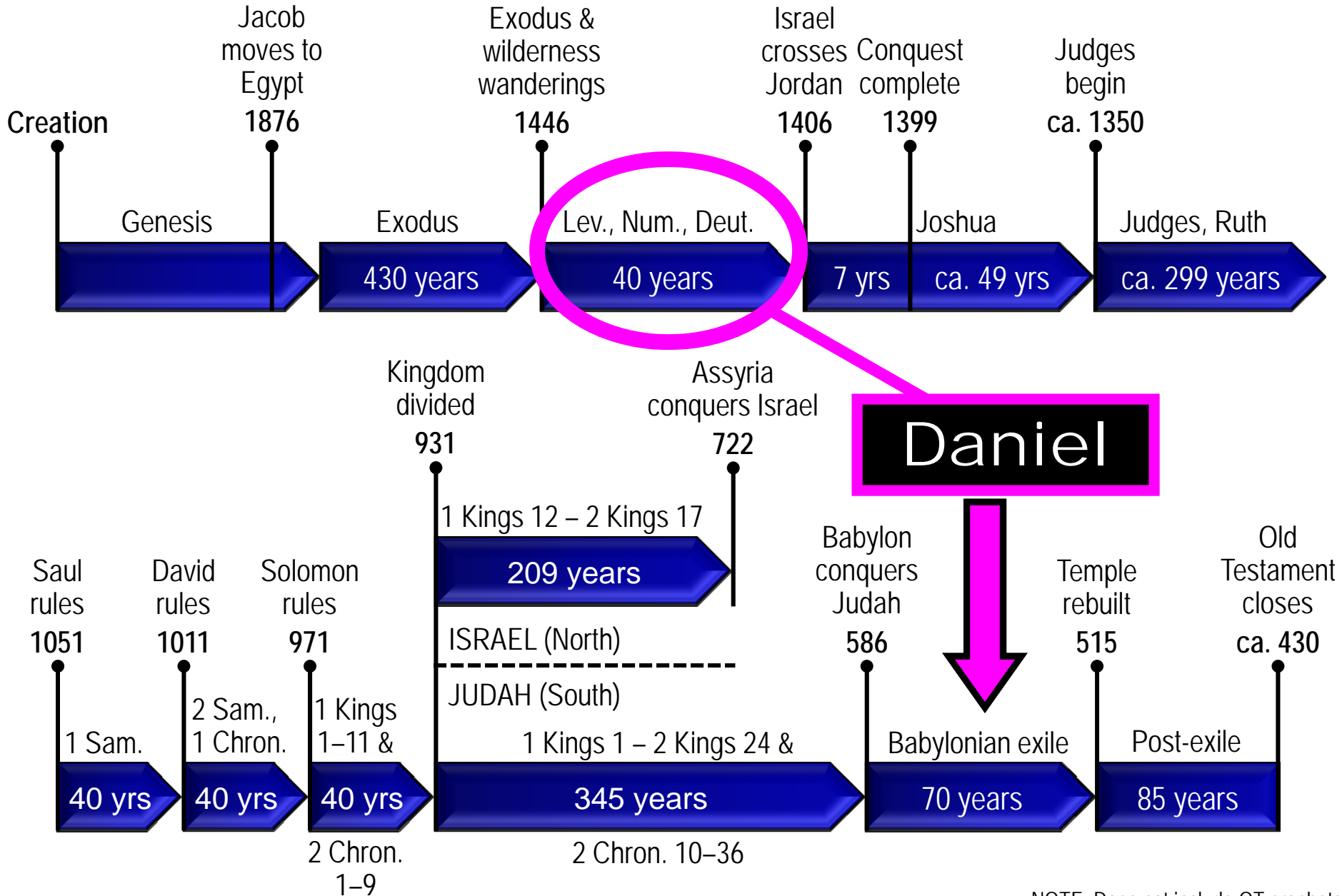

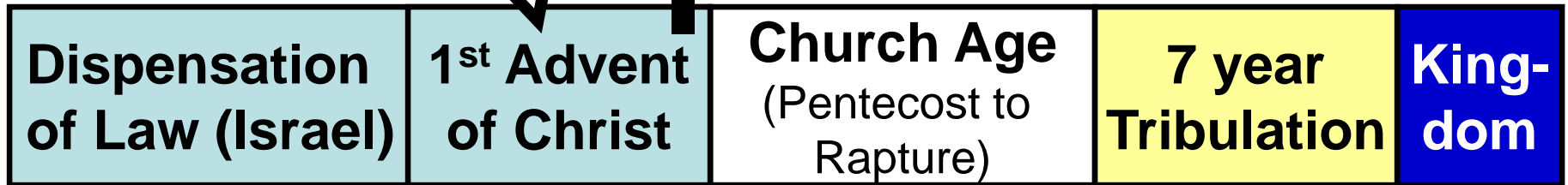


An Overview of Old Testament History



NOTE: Does not include OT prophets

The nation Israel was offered the kingdom by Jesus the Messiah (Matthew 1–11).
The King was rejected (Matthew 12).
Israel as a nation unfruitful (Luke 3:8; 8:4–15).
Kingdom temporarily withdrawn from Israel with a future generation of Israel producing fruit in the future kingdom (Matthew 21:43).



Romans 10:14-15 (in reverse order)

- 1) Preacher brings the good news
- 2) The message heard
- 3) The message believed (justification)
- 4) Call on the name of the Lord (salvation; Israel's deliverance into the Kingdom)
