The Epistle to the ROMANS



Rom. 3:9, "What then? Are we better than they? Not at all. For we have previously charged both Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin."

Rom. 3:10, "As it is written: 'There is none righteous, no, not one;

Rom. 3:11, " '<u>There is none who</u> <u>understands: There is</u> <u>none who seeks after</u> <u>God</u>.

Rom. 3:12, "'<u>They have</u> <u>all turned aside: They</u> <u>have together become</u> <u>unprofitable: There is</u> <u>none who does good,</u> <u>no, not one</u>.'" Psa. 14:1, "The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.

Psa. 14:2, "The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.

Psa. 14:3, "They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: <u>there is none</u> that doeth good, no, not one."

Ecclesiastes 7:20, "For there is not a just [צַּרִיק *tzaddiq*] man on earth who does good and does not sin."

Psa. 5:9, "For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; Their inward part is destruction; <u>Their</u> <u>throat is an open</u> <u>tomb; They flatter</u> <u>with their tongue</u>."

LXX

Psalm 5:9, "For there is no truth in their mouth; their heart is vain;

their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit." Rom. 3:13a,

"Their throat is an open tomb; with their tongues they have practiced deceit";

Psa. 5:9, "For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; Their inward part is destruction; <u>Their</u> <u>throat is an open</u> <u>tomb; They flatter</u> <u>with their tongue</u>."

LXX

Psalm 5:9, "For there is no truth in their mouth; their heart is vain;

<u>their throat is an</u> <u>open sepulchre; with</u> <u>their tongues they</u> <u>have used deceit</u>." Rom. 3:13a,

"Their throat is an open tomb; with their tongues they have practiced deceit";

Heykal (הֵיכָל) (Psa 5:7b) is also used of the tabernacle (cf. 1 Sam. 1:9; 3:3).

Psa. 140:3,

"They sharpen their tongues like a serpent; <u>the poison</u> <u>of asps is under</u> <u>their lips</u>. Selah" LXX

Psalm 139:3,

"They have sharpened their tongue as the tongue of a serpent; the poison of asps is under their lips. Pause." Rom. 3:13b,

... "The poison of asps is under their lips";

Psa. 10:7,

"His <u>mouth is full of</u> <u>cursing and deceit</u> and oppression; Under his tongue is trouble and iniquity." LXX

Psa 9:27,

"<u>Whose mouth is full</u> of cursing, and <u>bitterness</u>, and fraud: under his tongue are trouble and pain." Rom. 3:14,

"Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness."

Isa. 59:7, "Their feet run to evil, and <u>they</u> <u>make haste to shed</u> <u>innocent blood;</u> Their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; <u>Wasting and</u> <u>destruction are in</u> <u>their paths</u>.

Isa. 59:8, "<u>The way of</u> <u>peace they have not</u> <u>known</u>, and there is no justice in their ways; they have made themselves crooked paths; whoever takes that way shall not know peace."

LXX

Isaiah 59:7, "And their feet run to wickedness, <u>swift to</u> <u>shed blood</u>; their thoughts also are thoughts of murder; <u>destruction and</u> <u>misery are in their</u> <u>ways;</u>

Isaiah 59:8, "<u>and the</u> <u>way of peace they</u> <u>know not</u>, neither is there judgment in their ways; for their paths by which they go are crooked, and they know not peace." Rom. 3:15, "Their feet are swift to shed blood;

Rom. 3:16, "Destruction and misery are in their ways;

Rom. 3:17, "And the way of peace they have not known."
