


# Rom. 5:1, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Rom. 5:2, "through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God." Rom. 5:1, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, <u>we have peace</u> with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Rom. 5:2, "through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

#### What is "Peace?"



Rom. 5:1, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,"

Rom. 5:1, "Therefore, because we have been declared righteous,"

we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,???? OR

Let us enjoy peace with God (some early Greek manuscripts).

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
προσαγωγή, ῆς, ἡ *approach; access, admission,* to the presence of any one, Rom. 5:2; Eph. 2:18; 3:12

Eph. 2:11, "Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands—

Eph. 2:12, "that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world."

#### THE ALIENATION BETWEEN GENTILE AND JEW

- Gentiles were demeaned as "uncircumcised" by a key segment of 2<sup>nd</sup> Temple religious Jews. Eph. 2:12, cf., Rom. 2:25–29; 3:1–2; 4:10–12
- 2. Gentiles were thus separated from the Messianic Hope. Eph. 2:12, cf., Rom. 5:2–4
- 3. Gentiles were alienated from citizenship in Israel.
- 4. Gentiles were not party to the covenants. Eph. 2:12; Rom. 9:4–5; Eph. 3:6



#### THE ALIENATION BETWEEN GENTILE AND JEW

- 5. Gentiles were without hope-no expectation of a future afterlife.
- 6. Gentiles were atheoi, godless.

Eph. 2:13, "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ."

1 Cor. 12:13, "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit." Gal. 3:26, "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Gal. 3:27, "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Gal. 3:28, "There is <u>neither Jew nor Greek</u>, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Gal. 3:29, "And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and <u>heirs according to the</u> <u>promise</u>."

Eph. 2:14, "For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,"

Eph. 2:15, "having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, [enmity here is between God and man]

Eph. 2:16, "and that <u>He might reconcile them both to God</u> in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity [between Jew and Gentile]."


