Rom. 6:13, "And <u>do not present</u> your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but <u>present yourselves to God</u> as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Rom. 6:14, "For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
