1. Wisdom is the outworking of the omniscience of God. Such that what God performs is done on the basis of knowledge, but with skill and artistry.

2. Wisdom therefore is an eternal attribute of God.

3. Thus wisdom is also said to be part of the deity of Christ.

1 Cor. 1:24, "but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God."

Col. 2:3, "in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge."

4. Wisdom summarizes the end result of the application of doctrine in the life of the believer.

1 Cor. 2:6, "However, we speak wisdom among those who are mature, yet not the wisdom of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing."

Col. 3:16, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord."

Col. 4:5, "Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time."

5. Wisdom should be a focal point in our prayer.

Col. 1:9, "For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;"

James 1:5, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him."
