Matt. 11:2, “And when John had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples

Matt. 11:3, “and said to Him, ‘Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?’ ”

Matt. 11:4, “Jesus answered and said to them, ‘Go and tell John the things which you hear and see:

Matt. 11:5, “ ‘The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

Matt. 11:6, “ ‘And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me.’ ”

Gen. 49:10, “The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.”

Deut. 23:2, “One of illegitimate birth shall not enter the assembly of the LORD; even to the tenth generation none of his descendants shall enter the assembly of the LORD.”

Jer. 22:30, “Thus says the LORD: ‘Write this man down as childless, a man who shall not prosper in his days; for none of his descendants shall prosper, sitting on the throne of David, and ruling anymore in Judah.’ ”

Isa. 7:14, “Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin [*almah*] shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.”

Isa. 9:6, “For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

Luke 1:30, “Then the angel said to her, ‘Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

Luke 1:31, “ ‘And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.

Luke 1:32, “ ‘He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.

Luke 1:33, “ ‘And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.’ ”

Isa. 6:1, “In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

Isa. 6:2, “Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

Isa. 6:3, “And one cried to another and said: ‘Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!’

Isa. 6:4, “And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.”

Isa. 6:5, “So I said: ‘Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.’

Isa. 6:6, “Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar.

Isa. 6:7, “And he touched my mouth with it, and said: ‘Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged.’ ”

John 12:37, “But although He had done so many signs before them, they did not believe in Him,

John 12:38, “that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke: ‘Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?’”

John 12:39, “Therefore they could not believe, because Isaiah said again:

John 12:40, “ ‘He has blinded their eyes and hardened their hearts, lest they should see with their eyes, lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, so that I should heal them.’”

John 12:41, “These things Isaiah said when he saw His glory and spoke of Him.”

Isa. 40:3, “The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.’ ”

Matt. 3:3, “For this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah, saying: ‘The voice of one crying in the wilderness: “Prepare the way of the LORD; make His paths straight.” ’ ”

Lev. 19:3, “Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father, and keep My Sabbaths: I am the LORD your God.”

Matt. 12:8, “For the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath.”

Joel 2:32, “And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the LORD has said, among the remnant whom the LORD calls.”

Rom. 10:13, “For ‘whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.’ ”

Gen. 3:15, “And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”

Dan. 7:13, “I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him.”

Psa. 2:7, “I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.’ ”

Gen. 22:18, “In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

Psa. 132:11, “The LORD has sworn in truth to David; He will not turn from it: ‘I will set upon your throne the fruit of your body.’ ”

Gal. 4:4, “But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law,”

Matt. 22:41, “While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,

Matt. 22:42, “saying, ‘What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?’ They said to Him, ‘The Son of David.’

Matt. 22:43, “He said to them, ‘How then does David in the Spirit call Him “Lord,” saying:

Matt. 22:44, “ ‘The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool”’?

Matt. 22:45, “ ‘If David then calls Him “Lord,” how is He his Son?’

Matt. 22:46, “And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.”

Isa. 8:14, “He will be as a sanctuary, but a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.”

Isa. 28:16, “Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: ‘Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; whoever believes will not act hastily.’ ”

Psa. 118:22, “The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.”

1 Pet. 2:6, “Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture, ‘Behold, I lay in Zion a chief cornerstone, elect, precious, and he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame.’ ”
