- Prayer is communication with God.
- Prayer includes: Confession, Adoration, Thanksgiving, and Supplication (intercession and petition).
- Prayer gets nowhere without confession, Psa. 66:18.
- Prayer in itself is not a problem-solving skill, but it incorporates several problemsolving skills in its expression: Confession, faith-rest, trust, gratitude (grace orientation), love for God, reciting Scripture (doctrinal orientation).
