GOD OUR SHIELD

2 SAMUEL 15:1-37; PSALM 3:3-8



Psa. 3:0, "A Psalm of David when he fled from Absalom his son." NKJV

בְּרַת (*bāraḥ*) flee, run away, chase, drive away, put to flight, reach, shoot (extend), hurry away

Psa. 3:1,

"LORD, how they have <u>increased</u> who trouble me!
Many are they who <u>rise up</u> against me."
