



# Genesis 1:26

- ◆ Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground."

# Genesis 1:27

- ◆ So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

# Genesis 1:28

- ◆ God blessed them and said to them, “Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground.”

# The Image of God

- ◆ No formal definition given
- ◆ Gen 1:26, 27 not “in” but “as”
- ◆ *Doesn't describe what man is like but what he is to be and do.*
- ◆ Gen 1:26b, 28 Let them “rule” and “subdue”
- ◆ Man is God's Steward of the Earth!

# Psalm 8:4-5

- ◆ [W]hat is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor.

# Psalm 8:6-8

- ◆ You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet: all flocks and herds, and the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.

# God's Steward

- ◆ God's original plan was to have the earth ruled by man in his stead.
- ◆ *There is no evidence this plan has ever changed!*

# Results of the Fall

- ◆ Death
- ◆ Sinful Nature
- ◆ Worship and serve the creature rather than the Creator
- ◆ *No longer act as God intended!*

- ◆ The Glory moves from the ark to the threshold of the temple


# Ezekiel 10:4-5

- ◆ Then the glory of the LORD rose from above the cherubim and moved to the threshold of the temple. The cloud filled the temple, and *the court was full of the radiance of the glory of the LORD.* The sound of the wings of the cherubim could be heard as far away as the outer court, like the voice of God Almighty when he speaks.
