

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How Do We Walk "in the Light"? Ephesians 5:8–10



EPHESIANS

WEALTH 1:3-3:21

Prayer of thanksgiving to God for His provision of this new position in Christ. 3:14–21

WALK 4:1-6:9

Walk carefully in biblical wisdom. 5:15–6:9

WARFARE 6:10–20

Put on the whole armor of God that you may stand. 6:10–20

Eph. 4:1, "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called,"

Eph. 5:2, "And walk by means of love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma."


Eph. 5:8, "For y'all were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

Eph. 5:9, "(for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),

Eph. 5:10, "by evaluating to determine what is acceptable/pleasing to the Lord." [RD]

Three things we need to understand this passage:

- 1. What the Bible Teaches about Light
- 2. What the Bible Teaches about our Position in the Light, and
- 3. Our Walk in the Light
- 4. What the Bible Teaches about HOW we Walk in the Light.



14. Summary to this point.

- God is light.
- Jesus is the light of the world.
- Jesus' light brings life into the world, light and life are connected and dispel the darkness.
- But the darkness rejects the light.
- But the one who comes to the light, becomes sons of light and are to not abide in darkness.
- Satan is the master counterfeiter of light.

17. Our new legal position, adopted into the royal family of God, is LIGHT.

Eph. 5:8, "For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light."

1 Thess. 5:5, "You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness."



Temporal Realities

Rom. 6:3, "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized [identified] into Christ Jesus were baptized [identified] into His death?

Rom. 6:4, "Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."

18. But in our experience, we walk or think, talk, live <u>either</u> in the light <u>or</u> in darkness.

1 John 1:5, "This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

1 John 1:6, "If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.


1 John 1:7, "But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."

Eph. 5:8, "For you were once darkness [our position as unbelievers], but now you are light in the Lord [our new identity in Christ].

Walk as children of light!"

[But this implies we can walk like children of darkness]

1 John 1:6, "If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth."



Eph. 5:9, "(for the fruit of the Spirit* is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)," [NKJV]

There is a textual variant here. Some manuscripts (mss.) have "light," which fits with what is said in verse 8. It is possible that a copyist could have seen Light in the original and changed it to Spirit to be consistent with Gal. 5:22–23. Many translators choose this option—light is the original!

Gal. 5:22, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, Gal. 5:23, "gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law."

Conclusion:

The Scriptures consistently show a contrast between two possible options:

living like unbelievers or living like believers; walking in the darkness or walking in light; not abiding in Christ or abiding in Christ; walking according to the flesh or walking according to the Spirit.

John 15:5, "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."

The fruit is not described in John 15, but the reality is that walking in the Light, walking by the Spirit, abiding in Christ are each said to be the *necessary* and *sole* condition of fruit production in the Christian life.

Therefore they must be equivalent.

What is fruit production?

<u>Gal. 5:22</u>, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <u>Gal. 5:23</u>, "gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law."

Eph. 5:9, "(for the fruit of the Spirit/light is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)," [NKJV]

<u>Character transformation: to be Christlike—conformed to the image of Christ (Rom. 8:29)</u>

- 1 John 1:6, "If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice [apply] the truth.
- 1 John 1:7, "But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."

Eph. 5:9, "(for the fruit of the Spirit/light is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)," [NKJV]


Php. 1:11, "having been already <u>filled</u> with the <u>fruits</u> of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God."

Eph. 5:9, "(for the fruit of the Spirit/light is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)," [NKJV]

άγαθωσύνη agathōsunē fem sing dat goodness; the idea of goodness, generosity which benefits others. "Consist in the character of gracious generosity in kindness and benefits toward others"

δικαιοσύνη dikaiosunē fem sing dat expresses the quality of righteousness or justice. Here it speaks of our righteous actions.

ἀλήθεια alētheia fem sing dat truth, truthfulness, what is actual, in contrast to the false



John 17:17, "Set them apart by Your truth. Your word is truth." [RD]

John 17:19, "And for their sakes I set Myself apart, that they also may be set apart by the truth."

Contrast: BUT

Rom. 2:8, "but to those who are self-absorbed and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness—indignation and wrath [divine discipline in their lives]," [RD]

What then should be the result?

The Christian way of life begins with the walk <u>by</u> the Spirit; according to the Spirit; abiding in Christ; walking in the Light of God's Word, with the result that our thinking, decisions, priorities, relationships become transformed as we reflect the character of Christ.

John 15:7, "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ..." [NKJV]

John 17:17, "Sanctify them by means of Truth, Your Word is Truth."

Rom. 12:2, "... be transformed by the renewing of your thinking ..."

Understanding the "walk in the light!"

1. Jesus as the incarnate Logos ("word") is the incarnation of Truth itself.

John 14:6, "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Eph. 4:21, "if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as <u>TRUTH is in Jesus</u>: [RD]

Eph. 4:22, "that you have already put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man [our identity in Adam] which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,

Eph. 4:23, "and be renewed in the spirit of your mind,

Eph. 4:24, "and that you have already put on the new man [identity in Christ] which was created according to [THE] God, 'in righteousness and purity of the truth.' " [RD, HCSB]

Eph. 4:24, "and that you have already put on the new man [identity in Christ] which was created according to [THE] God, 'in [by means of] righteousness and purity of the truth.' " [RD, HCSB]

1. "By means of righteousness" describes the imputed righteousness which we receive at the instant we trust in Christ for salvation.

Gal. 2:16, "because we know that a man is not declared righteous by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be declared righteous by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be declared righteous." [RD]

Eph. 4:24, "and that you have already put on the new man [identity in Christ] which was created according to [THE] God, 'in [by means of] righteousness and purity of the truth.' " [RD, HCSB]

2. "By means of truth" describes the Word of God, both incarnate (the *Logos*, Jesus) and inscripturated.

John 17:17, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth."

John 17:19, "And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth."

- 1 Pet. 1:23, "having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,
- 1 Pet. 1:24, "because 'All flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away,
- 1 Pet. 1:25, "'But the word of the LORD endures forever.' Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you."

1 Pet. 1:22, "Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, (cf., Eph. 5:2 "walk in love.")

λόγος *logos* masc sing gen word, Jesus is the *logos*, the incarnate, "in the flesh" Word of God; the Bible is the written *logos*, Word of God.
