

The Sons of God and the Nations

Deut. 32:8-9;

Dan. 10:13-21

Psa. 82:title, "A Psalm of Asaph.

Psa. 82:1, "God [ $^{2}El\bar{o}h\hat{\imath}m$ ] stands in the congregation of the mighty [ $^{3}\dot{z}$   $^{2}el$ .]; He judges among the gods [ $^{2}el\bar{o}h\hat{\imath}m$ ]."



Rev. 12:7, "And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war,"

1. This is called the Table of Nations. The Table of Nations lists 70 nations but Israel is not one of them. Why? Israel is distinct and Abram isn't called out by God until Gen. 12:1.

2. Second, the use of the same Hebrew root (בַּרַד) in both Genesis 10 and Deuteronomy 32 to describe the "separation" of the human race and the nations substantiates the longrecognized observation that Genesis 10-11 is the backdrop to the statement in Deuteronomy 32:8.

Gen. 10:32, "These were the families of the sons of Noah, according to their generations, in their nations; and from these the nations were divided on the earth after the flood."

Deut. 32:8, "When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, when He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples according to the number of the sons of God."

3. Historically, the interpretation was that the seventy sons of Jacob were connected to the seventy nations in Gen. 10. The problem is that this doesn't work.

4. Conclusion: that God sets the "sons of God" over the nations.

<u>Deut. 32:8</u>, "When the Most High [*El Elyon*] divided their inheritance to the nations,

When He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the sons of Elohim (the angels)."

<u>Deut. 32:9</u>, "For the LORD'S <u>portion</u> is His people; Jacob is the place of His inheritance."

Rom. 1:18, "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Rom. 1:19, "because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.

Rom. 1:20, "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,"

Rom. 1:21, "because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Rom. 1:22, "Professing to be wise, they became fools,

Rom. 1:23, "and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

Rom. 1:24, "Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves,"

Dan. 10:13, "But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia."

Dan. 10:18, "Then again, the one having the likeness of a man touched me and strengthened me.

Dan. 10:19, "And he said, 'O man greatly beloved, fear not! Peace be to you; be strong, yes, be strong!' So when he spoke to me I was strengthened, and said, 'Let my lord speak, for you have strengthened me.'

Dan. 10:20, "Then he said, 'Do you know why I have come to you? And now I must return to fight with the prince of Persia; and when I have gone forth, indeed the prince of Greece will come."

Dan. 10:21, "But I will tell you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth. (No one upholds me against these, except Michael your prince."
