

<u>Gen. 9:1</u>, "So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: 'Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.' " <u>Gen. 11:5,</u> "But the LORD came down to see the city and the tower which the sons of men had built.

<u>Gen. 11:6</u>, "And the LORD said, 'Indeed <u>the people are one</u> and they all have <u>one language</u>, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them.' " <u>Gen. 11:7</u>, "Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech."

Gen. 12:2, "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; And you shall be a blessing."

Gentile, heathen, nation, people. ASV and RSV differ and agree in various instances, e.g., Gen. 10:5; via appears twice. <u>Both translate "nation"</u> in one instance, but RSV has "peoples" in the other. It is difficult to ascertain the exact definition of the term.

Gen. 12:5, "Then Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his brother's son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the people whom they had made, [not acquired] in Haran, and they departed to go to the land of Canaan. So they came to the land of Canaan."

<u>Gen. 12:7</u>, "Then the LORD appeared to Abram and said, 'To your descendants I will give this land.' And there he built an altar to the LORD, who had appeared to him." <u>Deut. 2:4</u>, "And command the people, saying, 'You are about to pass through the territory of your brethren, the descendants of Esau, who live in Seir; and they will be afraid of you. Therefore watch yourselves carefully.

Deut. 2:5, "Do not meddle with them, for I will not give you any of their land, no, not so much as one footstep, because I have given Mount Seir to Esau as a possession.

Deut. 2:6, "You shall buy food from them with money, that you may eat; and you shall also buy water from them with money, that you may drink." Deut. 32:8, "When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, When He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the children of Israel."
