Widow providence built into the Law

- Protection from affliction (Ex. 22:22–24)
- Food (Deut. 14:28-29, Deut. 24:19-22)
- Justice/fair treatment (Deut. 24:17-18)
- Continuation of the family line (Deut. 25:5-10)

Mark 12:41–44

41 And He (Jesus) sat down opposite the treasury, and began observing how the people were putting money into the treasury; and many rich people were putting in large sums. 42 A poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which amount to a cent.

43 Calling His disciples to Him, He said to them, “Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury; 44 for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to live on.”
