It is NOT a **Denial** of their abusive power.

It is an **Exposure** of the worthlessness of all their boasting.

Verse 10

Common Knowledge

- 1. Great Wealth
- 2. Great Intelligence

Neither one can deliver you from DEATH!

Verse 11

Their Secret Thoughts

- 1. They are the exception to the rule.
- 2. They will **live on through their estates** in some way.

Man in his Pomp:

"He Remains Not"

Verse 14

The Two Readings:

- 1. Death shall feed on them.
- 2. Death shall **lead them on**.
