

# Deuteronomy 11:29-32 NIV

### **Mountains and Freedom of Choice**

When the Lord your God has brought you into the land you are entering to possess, you are to **proclaim** on Mount Gerizim the blessings, and on Mount Ebal the curses.

As you know, these mountains are across the Jordan, westward, toward the (Way of The) setting sun, near the great trees of Moreh...

# Deuteronomy 27:1-4 NIV

### A Memorial on Mt. Ebal

When you have crossed the Jordan into the land the Lord your God is giving you, set up some large stones and coat them with *plaster*. *Write* on them all the words of this law when you have crossed over to enter the land ... And when you have crossed the Jordan, *set up these stones on Mount Ebal*, as I command you today, and coat them with *plaster*.

# Deuteronomy 27:5-8 NIV

### An Altar on Mt. Ebal

altar of stones. Do not use any iron tool on them. Build the altar of the LORD your God with <u>fieldstones</u> and offer <u>burnt offerings</u> on it to the LORD your God. Sacrifice <u>fellowship</u> <u>offerings</u> there, eating them and <u>rejoicing</u> in the presence of the LORD your God. And you shall <u>write</u> very clearly all the words of this law on these stones you have set up."

# Deuteronomy 27:12-26 NIV

### The ceremony

When you have crossed the Jordan, these tribes shall stand on Mount Gerizim to bless the people:

Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Joseph and Benjamin.

And these tribes shall stand on Mount Ebal to pronounce curses: Reuben, Gad, Asher, Zebulun, Dan and Naphtali.

The Levites shall recite to all the people of Israel in a loud voice:

- 1"Cursed is anyone who makes an idol—a thing detestable to the LORD, the work of skilled hands—and sets it up in secret." ---Then all the people shall say, "Amen!"
- <sup>2</sup> "Cursed is anyone who dishonors their father or mother." -- Then all ...
- <sup>3</sup> "Cursed is anyone who moves their neighbor's boundary stone." -- Then all ...
- 4 "Cursed is anyone who leads the blind astray on the road." -- Then all ...
- <sup>5</sup> "Cursed is anyone who withholds justice from the foreigner, the fatherless or the widow." -- *Then all* ...
- <sup>6</sup> "Cursed is anyone who sleeps with his father's wife, for he dishonors his father's bed." -- *Then all* ...
- <sup>7</sup> "Cursed is anyone who has sexual relations with any animal." -- Then all ...
- <sup>8</sup> "Cursed is anyone who sleeps with his sister, the daughter of his father or the daughter of his mother." -- *Then all ...*
- <sup>9</sup> "Cursed is anyone who sleeps with his mother-in-law." -- Then all ...
- 10 "Cursed is anyone who kills their neighbor secretly." -- Then all ...
- <sup>11</sup> "Cursed is anyone who accepts a bribe to kill an innocent person." -- Then all ...
- <sup>12</sup> "Cursed is anyone who does not uphold the words of this law by carrying them out." -- *Then all* ...

## Joshua 8:30-35

#### *Implementation*

30 Then Joshua built *on Mount Ebal* an altar to the Lord, the God of Israel, 31 as Moses the servant of the Lord had commanded the Israelites. He built it according to what is written in the Book of the Law of Moses—an altar of *uncut stones*, on which no iron tool had been used. On it they offered to the Lord *burnt* offerings and sacrificed *fellowship* offerings.

32 There, in the presence of the Israelites, Joshua wrote on stones a copy of the law of Moses. 33 All the Israelites, with their elders, officials and judges, were standing on both sides of the ark of the covenant of the Lord, facing the Levitical priests who carried it. Both the foreigners living among them and the native-born were there. Half of the people stood in front of Mount Gerizim and half of them in front of Mount Ebal, as Moses the servant of the Lord had formerly commanded when he gave instructions to bless the people of Israel.

## Joshua 8:30-35

#### *Implementation*

34 Afterward, Joshua read all the words of the law—the blessings and the curses—just as it is *written* in the Book of the Law.

35 There was not a word of all that Moses had commanded that Joshua did not read to the whole assembly of Israel, including the women and children, and the foreigners who lived among them.

Exodus 20:24-26 NIV

#### How to build an Israelite Altar

24 "'Make an altar of earth for me and sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, your sheep and goats and your cattle. Wherever I cause my name to be honored, I will come to you and bless you. 25 *If you make an* altar of stones for me, do not build it with dressed stones, for you will defile it if you use a tool on it. 26 And do not go up to my altar on steps, or your private parts may be exposed.'




# Emergency archaeological survey














### Sketch of the enclosure and inner divisions












A reconstruction of the structure

Base or Founding Altar


Gold and silver earrings from around the altar, designed in ancient Egyptian style.





<u>we – biblical scholars – should</u> <u>all go back to kindergarten".</u> Mt. Ebal Altar

- Discovered in 1980
- Excavated 1982-1989
- Final report was not published
- Oslo accords 1995 2019
- 1. Ignored by the academic world
- 2. The altar is rarely visited.
- 3. Muslim vandalism of the permitter wall and the altar itself



- Sent to the Academy Of Sciences in Prague for a Tomography check






#### Abstract


In December 2019, an expedition on Mt. Ebal to examine the discarded material from Adam Zertal's 1982–1989 excavation yielded a small, folded lead tablet. The east dump pile, from which the object emerged, contained the discarded matrix from two structures that he interpreted as altars dated to the Late Bronze Age II and Iron Age I. The earlier and smaller round altar law undermosth the geometric center of the later and larger restangular altar. The








# Mt. Ebal Lead Tablet Outer side

The name YHW appears 4 times

The names YHW and El appear together

Chiastic Parallelism- Expert scribe

Unvowelized AND vowelized Hebrew spelling

The most ancient version of Hebrew font

# Initial conclusions

Israelite religion (YHW)

Israelite ethnicity (Hebrew)

Israelite literacy

Possible strong connection to the ceremony of Blessings and Curses (Mt. Ebal is the mountain identified with the curses)

Late Bronze – Early Iron Age dating of the metal

The Altar and Foot structures are clearly Israelite

# Possible connection to the ceremony

Folded lead tablet is a sign for a legal document

Six cursed on one side and six on the other like the tribes

Total of Twelve "Cursed – Aroor" in total like Deut. 27

High skilled scribe (Craftsmen ship and authorship)

Curse is in the singular just like Deut. 27

Came from inside the altar – Important document

Writing - Engraving on Metal in the Bible

#### The Flying Scroll

I looked again, and there before me was a flying scroll.


#### The Woman in a Basket

He replied, "It is a basket." And he added, "This is the iniquity[b] of the people throughout the land."



# The Priestly Blessing

The Lord said to Moses, "Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them:

"The Lord bless you and keep you;

The Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you;

The Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."'

So they will **put my name on** the Israelites, and I will bless them."

Why is the altar built on Mt. Ebal, The Mountain of Curses?

Ezekiel 33:10 NIV

"Son of man, say to the Israelites, 'This is what you are saying: "Our offenses and sins weigh us down, and we are wasting away because of them. How then can we live?"'

Say to them, 'As surely as I live, declares the Sovereign Lord, I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but rather that they turn from their ways and live.
Turn! Turn from your evil ways!







