Resurrection Morning: Christ's Victory over Death

Rom. 4:25, “*Jesus* was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.”

Rom. 4:23, “Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him,

Rom. 4:24, “but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead,

Rom. 4:25, “who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.”

1 Cor. 15:3, “For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

1 Cor. 15:4, “and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

1 Cor. 15:5, “and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.

1 Cor. 15:6, “After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.

1 Cor. 15:7, “After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles.

1 Cor. 15:8, “Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.”

1 Cor. 15:12, “Now if Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?

1 Cor. 15:13, “But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen.

1 Cor. 15:14, “And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty.

1 Cor. 15:15, “Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God, because we have testified of God that He raised up Christ, whom He did not raise up—if in fact the dead do not rise.

1 Cor. 15:16, “For if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen.

1 Cor. 15:17, “And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!”

John 11:25, “Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

John 11:26, “ ‘And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?’ ”
