Q: *How much does the conference cost?*

Israel: Past, Present, and Future

October 7, 2023 is a day that will take its place alongside 9-11 and December 7, 1941. The worst mass murdering of Jewish people since the Holocaust. Initially the vast majority in the world reacted in horror, fully supporting Israel. If so, what significance do these events have? Why are the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob special? What is their destiny of promise? How should we as Bible believing Christians respond? What does the Bible teach about their future in His plan?

These and other questions will be addressed by the incredible group of speakers that have come together for this year's Chafer Seminary Pastors' Conference. Our prayer is that you will be informed, enriched, challenged, and blessed this year.

Randall Price, Th.M. in Old Testament, Dallas Seminary; Ph.D. Hebrew Literature and Middle Eastern Studies, University of Texas; post-grad work in archaeology, Hebrew University, Jerusalem. Former Distinguished

Research Professor of Biblical & Judaic Studies, Liberty University; President, **World of the Bible Ministries, Inc.** is author or co-author of 40 books and co-directs the Qumran Cave Excavation Project, Dead Sea, Israel. Dr. Price has traveled to Israel 110 times, including leading Israel tours and archaeological digs. He is married to Beverlee Price and they have 5 children and 13 grandchildren.

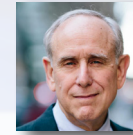

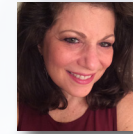

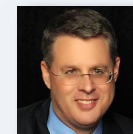
